General Condition for Field days

1. The Saltwater Flyrodders of Western Australia Inc. runs up to twelve (12) field days per year.
2. The field day calendar runs from December to November.
3. Club calendar can be found on the club web site. **saltwaterflyrodders.com.au**
4. Field days are not intended to be an ultra-competitive event. Their purpose is to foster and promote the club. It is a means for new members to get to know existing members, and learn from the combined knowledge of club members.
5. An annual prize for the field days shall be awarded at the AGM on a drawn raffle basis. Tickets for the raffle are distributed based on attendance and challenge winners as below.
 - One (1) ticket per paid entry to monthly field day.
 - One (1) ticket for submitting your catch sheet within 7 calendar days of completion of field day.
 - One (1) ticket for the winner/ winners of any challenges as set by the field day coordinator.

As an example, by entering, turning up, and submitting even a blank catch sheet, you will receive 2 tickets to the raffle.
6. Entry to field days is open to all financial members and can be entered in one of the following ways.
 - By paying an annual fee at the AGM for all field day entries for the following year.
 - By paying a monthly fee to the field day coordinator on the day.
7. Fish shall be measured from the tip of the nose to tip of tail, and rounded down to the nearest centimetre. If there is more than one capture at the same length, the challenge will be deemed a tie and tickets awarded to all tied entrants.
8. Catch sheets are on a honour based system. Any member deemed by the committee to knowingly have submitted a fraudulent catch sheet shall be made ineligible for that year's field day raffle.
9. Field day catches are only eligible to be submitted if they have taken place between the physical boundaries as set out on the catch sheet.
10. Field day catches are only eligible if they have taken place between the field days start and finish times as set out on the catch sheet.
11. The committee may choose to change or modify the field day due to circumstances. Ie, due to weather or clashing with another unforeseen event.
12. The field day coordinator and committee's decision on issues relating to the field day is final.
